



## **Red Rock Middle School Athletics Eligibility Rules and Regulations**

The Red Rock School District sponsors a comprehensive program for all students enrolled in 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades. Student participation in athletic activities is governed by the rules and regulations established by the Red Rock School District and the Superstition Athletic League. Failure to comply with these rules can cause an athlete to be declared ineligible and all contests in which the athlete participated in to be forfeited.

**Before a participant can PRACTICE, he/she must have on file:**

- Signed Athletic Participation Consent Form
- Completed Pre-participation Physical Evaluation Form (Completed by Doctor/CVS or Walgreens Clinics)
- Completed Annual Pre-participation Evaluation Form (Completed by Parent)
- Signed Acknowledgment of Rules and Terms for Participation Form
- Signed Mild Traumatic Brain Injury (MTBI)/Concussion Statement and Acknowledgment Form

Red Rock School District #5 does not provide medical insurance coverage for students who are involved in sports. The parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for all medical costs due to any injury that may occur during normal practice or actual competition.

Students involved in athletics will be issued school equipment. Students must return the exact equipment they were issued to avoid having to pay for its replacement. Equipment/uniform laundry directions should be carefully followed. Damage from improper laundering of equipment is the responsibility of the student. If the equipment is not returned within the 10 school days following the end of the sports season (whether lost or stolen), you will be automatically charged full replacement value for the equipment.

All students will travel to events on district transportation and will abide by all district bus rules and regulations (see student handbook).
