TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION

The District shall provide traffic safety instruction for eligible students. The Board shall determine if a fee is to be charged and the amount of the fee if applicable.

The Board directs the Superintendent to implement procedures dealing with program supervision; curriculum development; student enrollment criteria, including but not limited to grade level of student, age of student and enrollment status of student; student progress; and collection and refunding of student fees, and notice of the availability of fee waivers or reductions.
