Holiday Enrichment:

#1. Read the Prologue in Myers (pages 1-16). Take **detailed notes** as you read. Look at the charts, graphs, and colored pages as you read in any chapter. In addition, complete the Terms and Concepts on page 17 (14 terms) using a spiral notebook dedicated to this class only. See instructions on the blog on how to complete/setup the vocabulary in the notebook. Make sure to number each term!!! The notebook will help you review critical vocabulary through the course of the semester.

- #2. Using the SQ3R Method you learned in the Prologue (P.15-16), read Chapter One in your Myers text (pages 18-50) Take **detailed notes** as you read. In addition, complete the Terms and Concepts on page 51 (30 terms). Use the spiral vocabulary notebook as you did for the Prologue Terms. I will check ALL your work on January 5th.
- #3. Complete the Terms and Concepts in your vocabulary notebook for Chapter 2 on Page 93. Again, refer to the instructions on the blog if needed. Number these also. (56)
 *The January 5th test will NOT cover this material, but the material is still due.
 *Knowledge of psychological terms is vital in performing well in this class and on the AP Exam. Not only will you have to know the terms, you will be expected to apply them in various cases throughout the semester. Be prepared for an OPPORTUNITY (test) over the assigned material/vocabulary on January 5th. Excuses are not welcome so study!!!
