### What is Tax Credit for Kids?

## Background

In 1997, the Arizona State Legislature passed a law allowing a household to deduct, as a tax credit (better than a deduction) fees paid to schools for extracurricular activities.

#### Specifically:

- 1) The Arizona Department of Revenue allows a state tax credit for any amount up to \$200 for individual taxpayers, \$400 for married taxpayers filing jointly.
- 2) Your donation acts as a credit against any tax liability - not a deduction from income. Just bring or send a donation to Young Public School office. Then, when you fill out your 2020 Arizona tax return, you can subtract the amount of your contribution - up to \$200 maximum (\$400 for married couples filing a joint tax return) - from what you owe in taxes for the year. It's not just a deduction, it's a credit. For a change, YOU decide how your tax dollars are spent. 3) Tax credit funds are for extra curricular activities
- only. Note: Checks written from Business or Corporate accounts do not qualify for the tax credit program; checks must be from private accounts.

## How has YPS used Tax Credit Funds in the past?

- Send students on academic achievement reward field trips
- Send students on cultural field trips
- Send Junior High Students on biannual trips to Washington D.C.
- Maintain weight room
- FFA conventions and travel
- National Honor Society trips

#### Frequently Asked Questions

## Do I have to have children enrolled in school to contribute?

No. Any household may donate up to \$200 for individual filers, AND if you are married and filing jointly, you may donate up to \$400!

# Do I have to live with the boundaries of the Young Public School District?

No. Any household that pays Arizona state taxes may donate this fee to any district in the state. (You can recruit friends and relatives living elsewhere in the state to join you in supporting Young Public School!)

How does this work when I file my taxes?

You will file your donation as a tax credit, which means you will receive a full dollar-for-dollar value against your tax liability. As long as you contributed \$200/\$400 during the year, you can direct these funds to the school district of your choice.

#### What does it cost me?

ABSOLUTELY NOTHING IF YOU PAY MORE THAN \$200/\$400 IN AZ STATE INCOME TAX! It is a decision made by you as to who you want to receive your tax payment – our schools, or the Arizona Department of Revenue. Checks must be written from a private account, not a business.
