What do I do for my student?

If someone living in the home with the student tests positive for COVID-19

NOTIFY THE SCHOOL

The student will quarantine for 14 days from the positive test results. After the student quarantines for 14 days and has been fever-free for 72 hours with improved symptoms with no medication, the student may return to school (the student must quarantine from school even if the student receives a negative test).

If someone living in the home with the student is waiting for test results

NOTIFY THE SCHOOL

The student will quarantine for 14 days or until the patient's original test receives a negative result (provide documentation). Negative results for the student will not allow the student to return to school. The negative results must be based on the original person.

If the student was in close contact (less than 6 ft. for more than 15 minutes) with a person who has tested positive

NOTIFY THE SCHOOL

The student will quarantine for 14 days from the positive test results of the close contact person. After the student quarantines for 14 days and has been fever-free for 72 hours with improvement in symptoms with no medication, the student may return to school. (Student must quarantine for 14 days even if the student receives a negative test).

If the student is experiencing symptoms:

- Fever of 100 or more
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste, of smell
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

NOTIFY THE SCHOOL

A. If a student has been 72 hours symptom free with no medication, the student may return to school. OR

B. The student may return to school sooner with medical clearance from their doctor. Proper documentation is required.

If the student tests positive for COVID-19

NOTIFY THE SCHOOL

The student will be quarantined for 14 days. After 14 days of quarantine and the student has been fever-free for 72 hours and symptoms have improved with no medication, the student may return back to school.
