Drone Technology Teacher 2021-2022 School Year

Job Summary

The Drone Technology Teacher would teach one, two-hour session for 180 days to approximately 20 students. Additional days/time are compensated at the teacher's daily rate of pay. This rigorous training program is designed for students committed to a career in drone technology and aerial photography fields.

Personal Qualities

The person hired will need to be creative, but organized and be able to develop instructional programs based on engaging students, maximizing learning, and providing authentic assessments.

Duties

- Teaches Drone Technology class to prepare students for direct employment upon program completion
- Accesses multi-media technology for instructional purposes
- Develops daily lesson plans upon which instruction and assessment are based
- Reports student enrollment data
- Works with teachers, administrators and business and industry to improve and expand programs
- Assists students prepare for regional, state, and national SkillsUSA competitions

Job Requirements

- UAS remote pilot industry licensure and 3 years work experience in a related field
- Preferred: Associate's and/or Bachelor's degree in related field
- Preferred: Experience supervising and teaching high school youth
- Eligible for secondary teaching certificate
