

CAVIT ANIMAL CLINIC RELEASE AND AGREEMENT
2013-2014 School Year

Your animal is very important to us and we would like you to know that every effort will be made to make your animal's experience as safe and please as possible.

Health or Medical Problems

Please advise us of any medical, physical, emotional issues, allergies, sensitivities, or pre-existing conditions. These may include prior surgeries, hip or joint issues, warts, moles, ear infections or skin problems. If your pet has behavior problems, please let us know. If a possible health or medical problem is discovered during a service and/or your pet experiences a health or medical problem while being serviced, you will be notified. In case of medical emergencies, this release gives CAVIT authorization to seek medical treatment from the nearest veterinarian. **All veterinarian costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the animal's owner.**

Muzzles

CAVIT will advise you if muzzling is necessary to ensure the safety of both the animal and the student. Muzzling does not harm your animal. CAVIT has the right to stop or refuse providing services if it is felt that the service will cause undue stress or be harmful to the animal.

Animal Bite

In the event the student or anyone on CAVIT property is bitten by your animal, you the owner will be responsible and liable for any bites that required medical treatment including any property damage caused by your animal.

Matting

If your animal has matting which is difficult to remove, we may ask permission to clip or shave the hair. Please keep in mind that a matted coat can cause numerous health conditions including itching, irritation and skin infections. Removing a severely matted coat includes risks of nicks, cuts or abrasions. Heavy matting can also trap moisture near the animal's skin allowing fungus or bacteria to grow causing skin irritations that exist prior to the animal receiving services. CAVIT is not responsible for any pre-existing conditions due to a matted coat. For the safety of the animal and the student, it is asked that you do not interrupt the student during the service. Interruptions may cause the animal to move in a way that may cause an accident. CAVIT has the right to refuse services, stop a service, or cancel a service at any time before, during, or after grooming.

Release Form

I understand and do agree to the above terms for the service of my animal and in consideration of the animal services of CAVIT, agree to hold CAVIT harmless from damage, loss or claims arising from any known or unknown pre-existing condition of my animal. I authorize CAVIT to act as my agent in the event emergency veterinarian services, care-taking and/or transportation is necessary and I agree to pay all costs. I agree to hold CAVIT harmless from any and all damages, loss or claim which shall include, but not be limited to death, accident or injury.
