Arizona K-12 Standards

In 2015 the Arizona Board of Education voted to cut its ties with the Common Core Standards Organization. Since that time the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) has been making minor changes and adjustments to the Arizona K-12 Standards.

All public schools in the State are required to teach the standards as developed by the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) as approved by the Arizona Board of Education (ABE).

As a District we feel the standards adopted by the Arizona Board of Education are viable standards and when taught by dedicated and professional educators, provide students an excellent education.

Arizona College and Career Ready Standards (AzCCRS) is a term no longer used to describe Arizona's academic standards, they are now simply referred to as "Arizona K-12 Standards." The Arizona K-12 Standards provide a consistent, clear understanding of what students are expected to learn and master. The K-12 standards are designed to be robust and relevant to the real world, reflecting the knowledge and skills that our young people need to succeed.

Our State Standards include objectives developed by educators, content experts, researchers and community groups that clearly establish expectations for students to be best prepared to succeed in a global economy and society.
