ST JOHNS FOOD & NUTRITION PROGRAM (NSLP) - 2018-2019 School Year

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Breakfast/Lunch Application from the 17/18 school year is in effect for the first 30 school days of the 18/19 school year. A new application MUST be received each school year, prior to the end of the grace period. An application is given to each student to take home the first day of school, grades K-6. Applications are available to all students/parents in each campus office and each cafeteria.

There will be no increase in the Breakfast price for the Reduced or Full paying student. Breakfast for the Reduced student is \$.30 and for the full paying student \$1.30.

There will be no increase in the Lunch price for the Reduced student. The meal price is \$.40

There will be an increase in the Full Paying students Lunch price. This increase is a result of the Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act of 2010, under the Paid Lunch Equity clause in the legislation.

All schools on the National School Lunch Program must have in place a Wellness Plan. SJUSD developed the first plan in Spring of 2006 and it was adopted by the School Board in June 2006. It was minimally updated, Spring 2015. Latest School Board adopted Wellness Plan, December 2017.

Section 1 - Nutrition Education

Section 2 - Standards for USDA Child Nutrition Programs and School Meals

Section 3 - Nutrition Standards for Competitive and Other Foods and Beverages

Section 4 - Physical Education and Physical Activity

The 4 Committees are required to be staffed with School Personnel, (Classified & Certified & Administration), Students, Parents, Interested Community Members.
