- **What are the school hours?**

- 7:30 am – 3:20 pm Regular school day
- 7:30 am – 1:20 pm Early release Wednesday
- 7:30 am – 11:30 am Half day release

- **What are the meal prices?**

- Breakfast is \$1.75
- Lunch is \$3.10

- **What if my child requires medication during the school day?**

- If your child is on a medication that will need to be taken during the school day, please contact the Health Office at your student's school. All medication is to be provided and brought into the Health Office by a parent/guardian and a medication form will need to be completed with the health aide/nurse at that time.
 1. Prescription medication must be in the original prescription bottle. Over the counter medication must be brought in with the original label, in an unopened container.
 2. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to bring the medication to the Health Office.
 3. All medications to be taken during school hours will be kept in the Health Office.
 4. It is the responsibility of the student to report to the Health Office at the proper time to receive his/her medication.

5. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform the school (in writing) of any change in the student's health or change in medication. A physician's order must accompany any prescription medication change.
 6. Medication must be picked up by a parent/guardian on or before the last day of school. Medication not picked up will be discarded.
- If your student requires an inhaler for asthma or an Epinephrine Auto-Injector (EpiPen) for a severe allergy, please contact your school's Health Office. There are additional forms that must be on file. Students (age appropriate) are allowed to carry and self-administer asthma medication or an Epinephrine Auto-Injector for anaphylaxis only after the parent/guardian and physician have signed the appropriate action plans. (Action plans, available on FHUSD website, must be completed and returned to the Health Office at the beginning of each school year)
 - If your student has asthma, a severe allergy, diabetes, or a seizure disorder, a corresponding action plan will need to be on file in the Health Office. A new updated action plan will be required at the beginning of each school year.
- **Which Wednesdays are early release?**
 - On most Wednesdays, there is a 1-hour early dismissal for students at 1:20 (high school) or 2:10 (middle school) and 2:20 (elementary school) due to staff professional development. There are some Wednesdays that are full days due to a holiday during the week. Please refer to the district's [calendar](#) for our early release schedule.

 - **When should I expect a report card from my High School student?**
 - At Fountain Hills High School, we do not mail report cards. We use the real time student application PowerSchool. Parents and students can view all current or past grades, as well as class schedules, assignments, lunch balances etc. If you do need a report card for any reason, we will be glad to provide one at your request by reaching out to our Registrar.

- **How can I obtain a transcript for my High School student?**
 - For any transcript request, official or unofficial, we utilize the digital platform Parchment.com who then sends out transcripts digitally within 24 hours (excluding weekends.) Parents and students are always welcome to request the official or unofficial transcript to be mailed to their home address or picked up at the high school's registrar office.
- **Where can my child replace a lost ID?**
 - Students can purchase a replacement ID for \$5 in the library.
