

Have you been Identified as a "CLOSE CONTACT" to an individual who has COVID-19?

A student who has had an exposure to a COVID positive individual and is considered to be a "**CLOSE CONTACT**" will need to Quarantine for **10 full days from their last exposure** to someone with COVID-19, continue to monitor for symptoms consistent with COVID-19 and wear a mask for 14 days following their last exposure.

If you are unable to quarantine from the individual who has tested positive for COVID-19, you will have to quarantine for 10 days *after* the COVID positive individual's last infectious day, which is typically day 10 from their illness onset date. This is because a person with COVID-19 is considered to be infectious for 2 days prior to their symptom onset or positive test and 10 days after symptom onset or the positive test.

Special Exception~

A negative test *might* allow you to end quarantine after 7 full days (returning to school on day 8) if you have not had any symptoms. To see if your student might meet these criteria, please contact the District Nurse at 480-664-5501

****Early release from Quarantine with a negative test****

If an individual has:

- 1.) Tested for COVID-19 by PCR or antigen collected at least **5 full days following their last exposure (Specimen collected ON day 6)**
- 2.) Received the test result and it is Negative
- 3.) Been symptom free since exposure

The individual must meet all 3 of the above criteria to end quarantine and a copy of a lab report MUST be submitted to the health office *prior* to your student's return. (A picture of a text message of the lab results will not be accepted)
