

**Fountain Hills High School  
Student Community Service Agreement**

Fountain Hills High School believes that educating students includes teaching them the importance of being involved in their community. With this in mind, 24 hours of community service is required for high school graduation. Hours may be adjusted for new students. Below is a list of guidelines for community service:

- Community Service is **volunteer work** completed as a service to a **non-profit** organization. A list of suggested local organizations is available in the administration office. Hours may be denied at the discretion of FHHS administration if the service is deemed inconsistent with the spirit of “community service” as defined above.
- It is the student’s responsibility to turn in a completed “FHHS Community Service Agreement” for each project. **Hours will not be accepted without proper documentation.**
- Students in grades 9 – 11 are required to complete eight hours each year, thus fulfilling the required 24 hours by their senior year.
- **Parents, friends, relatives, or employers cannot sign as “supervisor” on the form.**
- Students may not miss class time to complete service hours.
- Campus club fundraising activities will not be accepted as community service.
- Campus club service activities may be accepted as community service. The student is required to get administrative approval prior to such activities.
