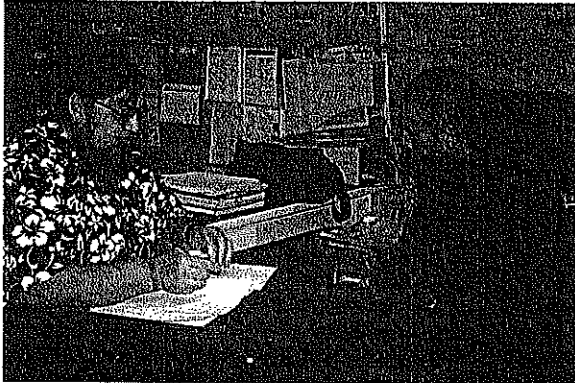


Characteristics of a successful Independent Study Student

Program Description

Tulare Adult School's (TAS) Independent Study offers a means of individualizing the educational plan for students whose needs may be best met through study outside the regular classroom setting. Independent Study students will meet with an instructor once per week for one-on-one instruction. Each student will work with his/her instructor to develop an individual educational plan that lists the courses and a time frame for completion.

How do I enroll in Independent Studies?

Students interested in the Independent Study program should contact TAS at 559-686-0225 to make an appointment with the counselor. After completing the orientation process and meeting all requirements, students may enroll in the I.S. program, pending availability.

NOTE: A \$40 cash book deposit is required prior to enrollment in the program. The deposit will be refunded when all books are returned.



When is Independent Study the Right Choice?

There are many reasons TAS's Independent Study Program may be an appropriate educational option. Most Independent Study students make the choice because of...

- The desire to accelerate in his/her educational journey

Who may enroll in Independent Study?
Independent Study is available to students who are at least 18-years-old and are working towards a high school diploma. Students must be responsible, motivated, and disciplined.

Yes. Students who successfully complete the Independent Study program will receive a diploma from Tulare Adult School. A graduation ceremony, complete with cap and gown, is held at the end of the school year.
