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Step by Step Admissions Guide for the Noble Leadership Academy

Step 1

Get to Know The Noble Leadership Academy

- Schedule a Meeting with our Inquiry Team
 - Consists of a meeting with two of our staff members and a school tour.
 - Have all your admissions questions answered.
 - Meetings are available M-F from 8:30am-3:00pm.

Step 2

Submit an Application Form and Fee

- Submit your application form with all areas of the document filled-in and signed. Return the form with the application fee (non-refundable) and a copy of the student's birth certificate.

Step 3

Schedule Testing

- Students entering PreK3-PreK4 are **exempt** from testing.
- Students entering KG-12th Grade are required to take an entrance exam in English and Mathematics in order to complete their candidacy for admissions to Noble Leadership Academy.
 - **KG/1st Grade** Testing is approximately 1hr long.
 - **2nd-12th Grade** Testing takes approximately 2 hours to complete (1hr is allotted for each subject). ***Students entering grades 7th-12th are required to bring a graphing calculator.***
- At the time of scheduling testing, students entering grades 7-12 are required to inform us of the current mathematics class that they are taking (i.e. Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, Trigonometry, Calculus, etc.)

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Step 4

Schedule a Family Interview and Student Interview (6th-12th Admissions only)

- Interviews are held daily within the time periods of 8:30am and 3:00pm.
- Both parents/guardians are required to be present at the time of interview.
- Parents will meet with members of our Interview Team.
 - A copy of the applying student/s' transcript/academic records are required at the time of interview.
- 6th-12th Grade Students will meet with our Guidance Counselor
- 6th-12th Grade Students are required to Submit their Recommendation Packet at the time of their Guidance Interview.

Step 5

Submit Registration

- Upon completion of your interviews you will be notified of acceptance via email and mail within 1 week.
