## ***Upland Unified School District to close campuses due to coronavirus concerns***

After careful consideration and out of an abundance of caution, the Upland Unified School District today announced a four-week closure of schools due to concerns about the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak.

All Upland Unified schools will be closed from Monday, March 16, returning on Monday, April 13. To ensure that learning is not interrupted, teachers and staff will provide students with enrichment opportunities through April 4. The week of April 6-10 is the District's previously scheduled Spring Break.

"We understand the disruption the closures will have on many of our families, and the decision to do so is not one we take lightly," said UUSD Superintendent Dr. Nancy Kelly, noting that while no cases of the coronavirus have been confirmed in San Bernardino County, the District is putting the safety and well being of its students and staff above all else.

"We appreciate everyone's support, and look forward to the return of normal school activity," Kelly said.
