

# UUSD ELEMENTARY RETURN TO IN PERSON INSTRUCTION

The safety of our students, staff, and our entire learning community has always been our highest priority. As we prepare to return to in-classroom learning, extensive health and safety measures have been implemented at all school sites and district facilities. Based on the guidance posted on January 22 by the California Department of Public Health, public schools in San Bernardino County can open with an adjusted COVID-19 case rate under 25 per 100,000 population for five consecutive days.

We are implementing the following reopening schedule for elementary schools. Once our district opens on February 25, we will remain open unless the state orders another round of school closures. Please note we have modified our tiered reopening plan to include every elementary school at each grade level.

Grade	Schools	Reopening Date
Transitional Kindergarten	All Schools	February 25
Kindergarten	All Schools	March 4
Family Conferences	All Schools; All grades	March 8-12th
1st-3rd Grade	All Schools	March 16
4th-6th Grade	All Schools	March 23



In order for secondary schools to open, our county COVID risk level must move from the current purple tier to the red tier and remain in the red tier for five consecutive days.
