

QUILL AND SCROLL BYLAWS

Purpose: Quill and Scroll is an international high school journalism honor society that recognizes and encourages both individual and group achievements in scholastic journalism.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

According to the Constitution, members of Quill and Scroll Honor Society must be chosen from students enrolled at Bishop Moore Catholic High School who, at the time of their election, meet ALL of the following requirements:

- a) Be at least a high school sophomore;
- b) Must have and maintain a 3.0 unweighted grade point average or higher;
- c) Enrolled and have produced superior work in Yearbook 1, Yearbook 2, OR Yearbook 3 Honors;
- d) Be recommended by the Yearbook Adviser (Mrs. Chwalisz);
- e) Be in good standing both with discipline and attendance at Bishop Moore.

Every new candidate must pay the one-time initiation fee of \$25.00. The fee entitles the new member to a pin or charm, a membership certificate, organization resources and a one-year subscription to *Quill & Scroll* magazine in either paper or electronic format. From year to year, members will pay \$10 to receive a new pin after they are initiated.

Membership is for one year only. When a student continues onto the next class they will be re-enrolled into the society, but do not have to pay an additional initiation fee. If a student enrolls in Yearbook 1 and meets the requirements for Quill and Scroll, but chooses to not take Yearbook 2, they will no longer be in Quill and Scroll.

Graduating seniors will be responsible for ordering their cords: \$15.

At any time, if a student fails to maintain the requirements from above (a – e), the Yearbook Adviser can dismiss the student from Quill and Scroll.
