

Student Records

The school board hereby authorizes the superintendent to do the following:

- Establish a uniform and systematic pupil accounting program that ensures accurate achievement, attendance, health, and other school records are maintained.
- Provide rules and regulations that govern access to student records that are consistent with state and federal privacy acts.
- Provide student directory information when appropriate and in a manner consistent with state and federal privacy acts.

Release of Student Records: Emergency Basis

Principals may disclose personal information about students without prior consent from the parents/guardians on the following basis:

- The disclosure is to appropriate agencies on an emergency basis in order to protect the health and/or safety of students or other individuals.
- Efforts to inform the parents/guardians are made as soon as possible.

Release of Student Records to Non-custodial Parents

In accordance with Idaho law, principals may disclose student information to non-custodial parents. The superintendent shall rule on governing such requests.
