

Cantus Choir Uniform FAQs



Welcome to Cantus Choir!

As a member of Cantus Choir, your singer will be required to wear a uniform.

- ❖ Girls will be wearing a black dress with a red feather or purple headband.
- ❖ Boys' uniform is a red or white tie to be worn with a black dress shirt and black slacks.

The uniform fitting and ordering process for Cantus choir is managed by Julie Schlarmann and Ellen Stellburg, parent volunteers. You may contact them for any questions on uniforms.

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What should I expect to pay for a uniform?

Each singer will be required to pay a Performance Fee due at registration which will cover the cost of the uniform and other participation expenses.

- Annual fee for a full season: \$50
- Mid-Season (January) discounted fee: \$40
- Cantus boys will be charged a discounted fee: \$25

How is the size determined?

- A parent must be present during fittings.
- Size is determined by trying on pieces from our inventory and/or measuring.

When/how will the uniform be delivered?

- You may be able to take home your uniform the same day of the fittings.
- If we need to order a uniform, it will then be delivered at a later date.
- No uniform will be delivered until the Performance Fee has been paid-in-full.

What other items do I need to provide?

- ❖ Your daughter will need:
 - ✓ Black pantyhose
 - ✓ Black, closed-toe, flat or low-heeled dress shoes

Parent Tip: Keep an extra pair of pantyhose on hand for unexpected emergencies!

- ❖ Your son will need:
 - ✓ Black dress slacks with black dress belt
 - ✓ Black, long sleeved dress shirt
 - ✓ Black socks and black dress shoes

Parent Tip: Slacks and shirt look nicer if they're ironed! Try on shoes a few days prior to performances to make sure they fit!
