Applicants must meet the following minimum qualifications:

1. Applicants must be high school graduates or must have successfully passed the GED equivalent. Applicants who do not meet the educational requirement who have worked in the trade for a minimum of 2,000 hours and upon the written recommendation of the employer will be considered for entrance into the program.
2. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
3. Applicants must be physically fit to perform the work of the trade. A physical examination will be required after selection by the Committee and before placement on the job, such examination to be performed by a physician acceptable to and at the expense of the sponsor.
4. Applicants must have some mode of transportation to the Employer's place of business and/or job site and to the place where classroom job related instruction is conducted, and have a valid driver's license.

Applicants who meet the above minimum qualifications will be required to furnish a transcript of high school grades or GED **at time of application**. Qualified applicants will be notified when and where to appear for a personal interview.
