This letter is to remind you of the two scholarships available through Lincoln County Medical Center. The Board of Trustees awards a 1st place (\$1000/year for a maximum of four years) and 2nd place (\$1000 one-time) scholarship. Guidelines to apply and maintain the scholarship are as follows:

- Student must be a graduate of a Lincoln County high school.
- The scholarship is awarded for use in a **healthcare** field only. Student may attend any accredited two- or four-year institution and must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.
- Scholarship must be used within the academic year following graduation from high school.
- Student must present a completed application, 2 **academic** letters of reference, current transcripts (to include ACT scores) and a short essay on why you feel you should be considered for the scholarship as well as where and how you would use your ultimate education.
- Application must be received **OR** post-marked by April 25, 2016.
- The Scholarship Committee will review grades annually. A grade point average of 2.8 (on a 4.0 scale) and a healthcare major must be maintained for continued scholarship up to 4 years. If the grade point average drops below 2.8, the recipient must then appear before the Board of Trustees at LCMC to provide reasons why the scholarship should continue.
- Documentation must be provided annually during the summer months to show grades, healthcare major and intentions to continue the scholarship for the next school year.
- A scholarship check will be made out to the recipient's school of choice. At the time the check is received, the student will be asked to sign an acknowledgement of the amount and conditions of the award for subsequent years.

**CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP
2016**

- **Must be a graduate of a Lincoln County high school.**
- **Scholarship will be awarded for use in a healthcare field only. May attend any two or four-year institution. Must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours.**
- **Scholarship must be used within the academic year following graduation.**
- **A completed application, 2 letters of academic recommendation and a short essay on why you feel you should be considered for the scholarship as well as where and how you would use your ultimate education, are required.**
- **The application must be received or post-marked by April 15, 2016.**
- **The Scholarship Committee will review grades annually.**
- **A grade point average of 2.8 (on a 4.0 scale) must be maintained for continued scholarship up to 4 years. If grade point drops below 2.8, the recipient must appear before the Board of Trustees at LCMC to provide reasons why the scholarship should be continued.**
- **A letter must be written annually during the summer months to show grades, continued healthcare major and intention to continue scholarship for the next school year.**
- **The check for scholarship will be made out to the recipient's school of choice.**
