STUDENT COUNCIL

S.T.E.A.M. CLUB

Students with an interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art or Math practice skills in a fun environment and apply their talents as they represent Ridgway High School at the Envirothon and Science Olympiad Competitions. Students work cooperatively to problem solve. **Envirothon** provides students the opportunity to compete in field testing using their knowledge in five topic areas – Soils and Land Use, Aquatic Ecology, Forestry, Wildlife, and Environmental Issues. **Science Olympiad** consists of events to reflect genetics, earth science, chemistry, anatomy, physics, geology, mechanical engineering and technology. Emphasis is placed on active, hands-on group participation. Students with any skillset are encouraged to get involved.

FRENCH CLUB
