

RIDGWAY ELKER PRIDE AND SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS AWARDED TO THE GRADUATING SENIOR FROM RIDGWAY AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT WHO HAS SHOWN CONSISTENT ELKER PRIDE IN HIS/HER RIDGWAY HIGH SCHOOL CAREER WHO HAS AT LEAST A 2.5 GPA. THE AWARD IS BASED ON PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES, LEADERSHIP AMONGST PEERS AS IT PERTAINS TO SCHOOL SPIRIT, VOLUNTEERING IN COMMUNITY SERVICE AND SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTIVISM IN A MANNER THAT ENHANCES ELKER PRIDE AND THE RIDGWAY STUDENT EXPERIENCE. THIS IS A FOUR-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP.

For consideration, this application must be completed and returned to the guidance office by ______. All applications must be received at the Elk County Community Foundation office from your guidance office no later than April 1. There will be no exceptions. The Scholarship Selection Committee, appointed by the Board of Directors of the Elk County Community Foundation, will select the scholarship recipient.

The Ridgway Elker Pride and Service Scholarship

The Ridgway Elker Pride and Service Scholarship is a 4-year scholarship of \$1000 per year for student with a minimum 2.5 GPA. This scholarship is awarded to the Graduating Senior from Ridgway Area School District who has shown consistent Elker Pride in his/her Ridgway High School career. The measurement of this award is based on participation in extracurricular activities, leadership amongst peers as it pertains to school spirit, volunteering in community service (over and above the minimum 15 hours required by the school district) and school district activism in a manner that enhances Elker Pride and the Ridgway student experience. This scholarship does not consider financial need in the criteria for award.

TERMS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

The committee will grant the **Ridgway Elker Pride and Service Scholarship** as instructed. The selection of students to receive scholarship grants shall be made by the committee without regard to race, religion or sex of the applicant or their political perspectives. The committee will not place restrictions upon a candidate's choice of college or university.

The committee shall require, prior to the disbursement of any scholarship, proof that the scholarship recipient is actually enrolled as a student at the educational institution for which the grant is made, and all scholarship grants shall be paid only to the education institution attended by the recipient and never directly to the recipient. This grant covers tuition, fees, and books for the applicable fall, winter, or spring quarter.

The Elk County Community Foundation is approved as a PATH Program participant.

If you are awarded a scholarship of at least \$500 from the Community Foundation, we will submit your name to AES/PHEAA for additional scholarship funding through PATH. To be eligible for the PATH award, you must meet the following criteria: be enrolled in an approved Pennsylvania College or career school; be a State Grant recipient and have a Federal Student Loan; and demonstrate financial need for PATH Program Grant. PATH grants will not exceed the Maximum State Grant for the particular academic year.
