Thursday of the Lord's Supper - Evening Mass


Tonight we commemorate the Last Supper, the evening that our Savior instituted the Eucharistic Sacrifice of his Body and Blood. At the end of Mass, there will be a short procession from the altar to the Church doors. We ask that you remain in your seat and follow the procession visually to where we will place the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Before Mass begins, we will receive the holy oils that were blessed by our Archbishop earlier this week at the Chrism Mass. These oils are used throughout the year for different sacramental purposes. This year, our oils will be presented by members of our community:

Oil of the Sick

Oil of the Catechumen

Sacred Chrism






