



MPCS Elementary Reopening Plan

2020/2021 School Year

School begins August 10th

- Touchless thermometers will be used to take temperatures upon arrival each day.
- Mask may be worn at school, but not required at this time for staff and students.
- Student movement throughout the campus will be limited.
- Frequent hand washing and sanitizing will be built into the day.
- Student supplies will be limited to single-student use - no community supplies.
- Recess will be separated – classes will have assigned recess locations and times.
- Meals will be eaten in the gym with tables spread out and each class will sit at their designated table, separate from other classes.

School begins August 10th

- Student desks for 1st -5th grades will face the same direction and not be touching one another.
- K4 and K5 tables will have assigned student seats with no more than 4 students at a table.
- Sanitizing pumps have been installed in each classroom and in common areas around the campus.
- Students will need to be dropped off at the designated areas. Parents will not be able to walk students to their classrooms.
- Visitors/volunteers (including parents) will be on hold for the first nine weeks at minimum.
- No field trips will be taken for the first nine weeks at minimum.
- We will follow the Escambia County School District protocol if/when students show symptoms of illness and/or positive cases are reported.

Back to School Night – Thursday, August 6th

- Teachers will contact parents Monday and Tuesday August 3rd and 4th to introduce themselves and walk parents through Back to School Night options.
- Option 1 – Virtual
 - We are asking all returning students to join us virtually via Facebook Live.
 - General assembly live stream will begin at 6:00 p.m.
 - Class specific live streams will begin at 6:30 p.m.
 - All videos will be able to be viewed after the live stream as well.
- Option 2 – In Person
 - New students may join us virtually or in person.
 - Students with last names A-L, BTS Night begins at 6:00 p.m. in the Worship Center.
 - Students with last names M-Z, BTS Night begins at 6:30 p.m. in the Worship Center.

Extended Care for the week of August 3-7

- Summer Camp officially ends Friday, July 31st.
- Extended care is available for Monday through Wednesday August 3rd through 5th.
- Students must be signed up for extended care. Sign up sheets are available at each reception desk.
- There will be no extended care available Thursday and Friday, August 6th and 7th to allow time for a deep clean of our facilities.
