

Dear Parents,

As the school year winds down, we want to say thank you again for your support of our school throughout the year and especially during the transition to distance learning due to Covid-19. We truly have the best parents, and we are grateful to be a part of your child's education!

A few important announcements:

We will be issuing 4th Qtr. grades so that our students will have completed report cards for this year. We will be averaging their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Qtr. grades with a distance learning completion grade to calculate their 4th Qtr. grade. All assignments must be turned in by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 15th, to receive credit. We will be mailing report cards by Friday, May 22nd.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to host an end of the year awards ceremony on campus. We will be issuing certificates for students that achieved Principal's List, Honor Roll, and highest Academic Average by subject for the school year. These will be based on the first three quarters; no academic awards will be given for the 4th Qtr. Our teachers will be hosting virtual award ceremonies with their classes, and will send certificates home on Tuesday, May 19th, at the final drop-off. We will mail any certificates that are not picked up when we mail report cards on Friday, May 22nd.

Our 5th graders typically get "sent off" through a tunnel of all of our students at the end of the year awards ceremony. Since we won't be able to do that this year, we are planning to do a "reverse tunnel." Our 5th graders will line up outside the elementary building, creating a tunnel, and friends and family will drive through the tunnel and honk and wave to our kiddos. We will have more details on that soon, but let's all plan to be there to support them on Wednesday, May 20th, at 11:00 a.m.!

The final drop-off of all curriculum will be on Tuesday, May 19th. Please follow guidance from your teacher on what needs to be returned to school and what you may keep.

We will follow the previous pick-up/drop-off times for each grade level. If you have multiple children, please follow the pick-up time of your oldest child.

All curriculum should be dropped off at the Elementary, "D", Building along Industrial Blvd. We ask that you please stay in your vehicle and we will take your student's items from you.

If you are unable to drop-off your packet during the scheduled times, please let your teacher know and we will arrange a time that works best for you.
