Dear Mr. Dwyer:

On November 3, 2020 Pinal County Public Health Services was advised of a novel coronavirus (COVID-19) case at Red Rock Elementary School. Per **Arizona Department of Health Services Emergency Measure 2020-03**, "*Slowing the Spread of COVID-19: Reporting Requirements*," school personnel notified Pinal County Public Health. At this time, Public Health supported the school's mitigation efforts and response. School leadership was provided guidance and resources, including templates of quarantine letters and available COVID-19 test sites.

School leadership maintained contact with public health throughout the week. A virtual conference call was held with school leadership on 11/10/2020 at 1100 hours to discuss the unfolding circumstances at Red Rock Elementary School, including multiple persons who are awaiting COVID-19 test results.

In collaboration with public health, school leadership determined that Red Rock Elementary School's response would be modified to: ***temporary closure of onsite (in person) learning from 11/12/2020 through 11/29/2020 with return to onsite learning on Monday, 11/30/2020.*** Pinal County Public Health supports the school's response and will continue to offer guidance.

Thank you for taking responsibility for the health and well-being of your staff, students and the community. May those who are ill have a quick and full recovery to health.
