Dear Red Rock Families,

We are looking forward to the return of your children to In-Person Learning. Many families have questions and concerns about what returning to school will look like for their children. [Red Rock Elementary School District's Mitigation Plan](#) offers many answers to your questions. However, now that your child will be coming back on to campus, it is important that you know what to expect and how to prepare your children. Below are some of the key points to remember before your child returns to school this upcoming week.

- Red Rock Elementary School Chromebooks need to be returned with your child upon their return to school.
- As a reminder, in an abundance of caution visitors will not be allowed on school grounds. Parents are asked to call the office ahead of time and schedule an appointment. Please remember, when dropping your child off before school begins, parents will not be permitted to walk their child to class.
- Per CDC recommendations, communal water fountains will not be in use. Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle to school each day. Water bottles may be refilled in their classroom throughout the day.
- In order to be in Red Rock Elementary's Distance Learning, we are asking families to commit to a quarter of learning at a time. For example, if you have chosen to continue with Distance Learning, your child will finish quarter one in that learning model. Parents will have the choice for the second quarter to continue with Distance Learning or begin 5-days a week In-Person Learning.

- As a reminder, In-Person Learning will have a five days a week attendance requirement, although we understand absences happen.
- Per Governor Ducey's Executive Order 2020-51, all students over the age of five and staff are required to wear face coverings at school when social distancing is not feasible.
- It is important that all of our students are screened at home before they come to school each day. Please refer to our mitigation plan for signs and symptoms.
- Your child's teacher will be sharing with you updated information about daily schedules and times.
