We know you have questions regarding when we will be able to return to the hybrid in-person learning model. At Tuesday's Board Meeting, our Governing Board voted to remain on full time dynamic distance learning through winter break. This means we will not have in-person learning prior to January 4th. This decision was made in the best interest of our students, staff and community's health and safety.

The District will continue to monitor the Maricopa County Department of Public Health's benchmark metrics on a weekly basis. The Governing Board will discuss a school reopening date of January 4th at their next regular meeting on December 8th.

Please continue to do your part to stop the spread of COVID-19. Wear a mask, stay home when sick, stay six feet apart, wash your hands regularly for at least 20 seconds and limit your social gatherings. By working together, we can take the appropriate steps toward keeping our community healthy and be able to reopen our schools for in-person learning in January.
