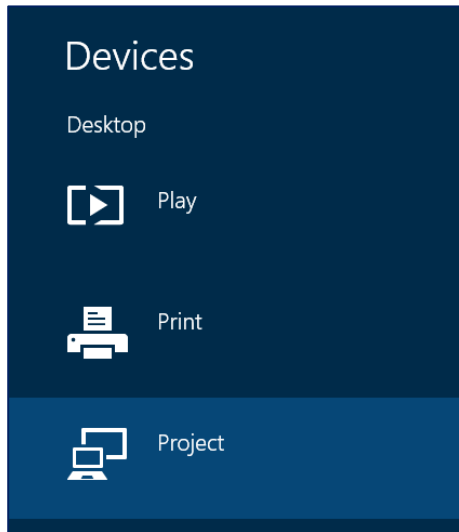
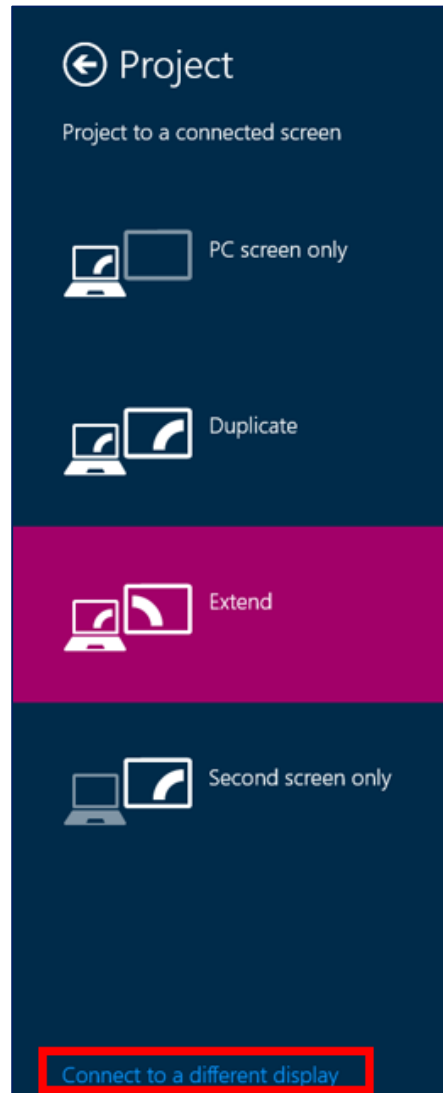


# TUHSD TECH QUICK GUIDE – Connecting to WiDi on Windows 8.1

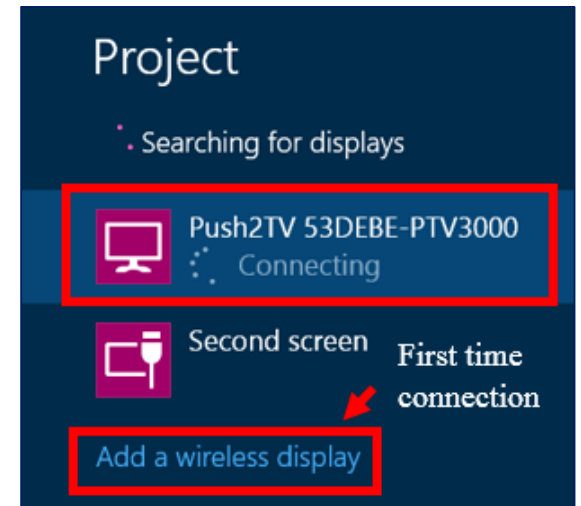
1. Access the **Charms** icons by swiping from the right edge of the screen, placing the cursor on the top-right or bottom-right corner of the screen, or typing Windows Key + C.
2. Tap/Click on **Devices**.
3. Tap/Click **Project**.



4. Tap/Click **Connect to a different display**.



5. Tap/Click **Add a wireless display** if you are connecting to the WiDi device for the first time. Otherwise, tap/click the name of the WiDi device you wish to use.

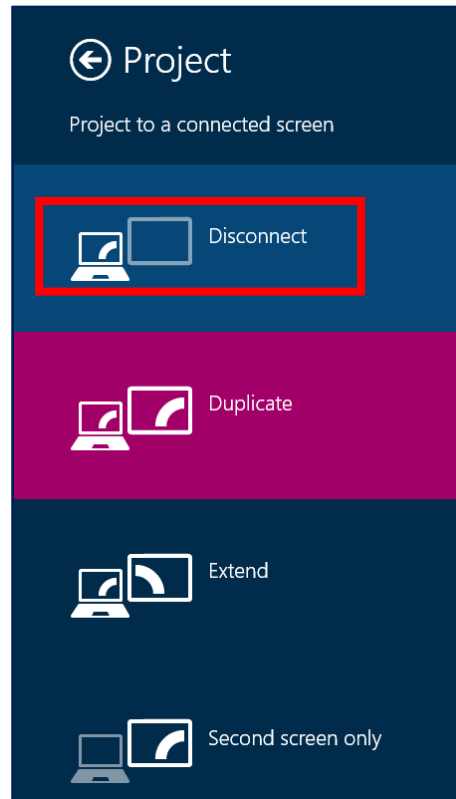

- 6. Select the WiDi deCvice you wish to add. The device name will be displayed on the projected screen under **Adapter name**. See examples below.
- 7. The computer will connect to the WiDi device once the display is added. Note: the screen(s) may blink as this connection is made.



- 8. To disconnect from WiDi, access the **Charms**, select **Devices**, choose **Project**, and tap/click **Disconnect**.



To use the Helix tablet stylus and project that screen on the screen, right-click on the desktop. Click Screen Resolution.

- 1. Click **Identify** to note which display belongs to the Helix and which belongs to the projector.
- 2. Click on the monitor icon for the Helix.
- 3. Beside **Multiple displays**, select **Duplicate desktop on \_\_ and \_\_** (use the display numbers noted in step 1 above).
- 4. Click **Apply** > **Keep changes**.
