ADMISSIONS & WAITING LIST POLICY

Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish recognizes its calling to serve the people of the parish by providing an education for our children based on the mission of the teaching of Jesus Christ and a tradition of academic excellence. To foster the spiritual, intellectual, and physical growth of the children entrusted to our care is the primary goal of Our Lady Queen of Peace School.

The following standards have been set for consideration of admission of students to Our Lady Queen of Peace School.

- Children are accepted without regard to race, sex, color, national or ethnic origin.
- A Child must be four years old by September 1 to enter K4 program and five years old by September 1 for Kindergarten.
- Applications for admission are accepted throughout the year and all applicants are placed on a waiting list pending space availability. To ensure proper placement on our waiting list, parishioner status will be determined at the time of application.
- All applicants seeking parishioner status must:
 - a) officially register as parishioners and attend Our Lady Queen of Peace Church regularly as a family and participate in the sacramental programs.
 - b) volunteer in both time and talents to Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish.
 - c) support Our Lady Queen of Peace financially as determined by parish finance council yearly.
- Admissions Priority List:
 1. Children currently enrolled in the school.
 2. Siblings of parish children already enrolled.
 3. Siblings of parish children who have already graduated from the school.
 4. Children of families who are active members of the parish (determined by Status).
 5. Siblings of non-parishioner students already enrolled.
 6. Children of families from other parishes who have recently registered at Queen of Peace.
 7. Non-parishioners.
 8. Non-Catholics.
- No child will be denied admission to the school for financial reasons alone. The Parish's Grant Committee may make exceptions in cases of financial need.
- A placement test may be given to new students. The result of the placement test, along with previous school records, and interviews with parents, student, administrator, and teachers of previous school may result in admission being denied.
- The waiting list application does not represent final admission into the school, but rather is an application for admission and a determining vehicle for placement on the official waiting list.
