SUMMARY OF RETURN TO SCHOOL ATTENDANCE PLAN FOR 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR

STARTING THE SCHOOL YEAR

**INFORMATION FOR OBTAINING STUDENT USER NAMES & PASSWORDS WILL BE COMING SOON*

- 1) Begin August 10 with Distance Learning model
- 2) Begin Hybrid/Flex Learning Model August 24 (*or within 1 week of Governor and State Superintendent lifting in-person learning restrictions*)

Details:

- **A/B Schedule** - All staff on campus daily teaching normal class schedule with 1/2 students present.
2 Days per week on campus (**[A]Monday/Thursday** - **[B]Tuesday/Friday**)
**all students from a household will attend on the same days*
Wed = Extra Tutoring and/or Virtual Sessions as needed
 - **Food Service** - Will operate like the summer meals program until the A/B schedule begins.
Will operate in a modified seating schedule for students on campus each day.
Students who are not on campus for the day will be able to pick up their meals between 9:00-10:00 am
or 12:30 - 1:30 pm
 - **Temperature** - Student temperature will be taken prior to boarding the morning bus
Student temperature will be taken before entering 1st period class by teacher
[Temperature must be below 100.4 degrees]
- 3) Revert to 5 day per week on campus **if/when** COVID-19 conditions have been revised to achievable guidelines.

DISTANCE LEARNING by Choice

The school will also provide families with a 100% distance learning option for any student though a fully structured online curriculum. Tutoring provided on Wednesdays (and/or during planning periods as time permits).
