PRESCHOOL ENTRANCE GUIDELINES

The maximum number of students (special education and typically developing) will be fifteen (15) per session.

The following guidelines will be followed:

- A parent/guardian of a child who lives within district boundaries may contact the office to have their child screened for preschool entrance. All requests for preschool need to be in the school office no later than first Monday in August.
- Priority enrollment will be given to those students who have been identified as having a special education need.
- After the final number of special needs students has been determined (early September), and if there are slots remaining, typically developing children will be chosen by lottery in the following order:
 - 4 year old children/grandchildren of employees
 - 4 year old children of parents living in the district
 - 3 year old children/grandchildren of employees and parents living in the district
- Typically developing children (if any) chosen in the lottery will begin preschool on the first day of school in October.
- If throughout the year a preschool child moves into the district and qualifies for special education services, it will be necessary to take the last typically developing child chosen in the lottery out of preschool.
