

ACKNOWLEDGMENT CONCERNING USE OF STUDENT PARKING LOTS

I acknowledge and understand that:

- ⇒ Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not a right.
- ⇒ The District retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property.
- ⇒ As part of the routine patrols, the District may observe items that are in plain view on the dashboard or seats of a vehicle.
- ⇒ Dogs trained to locate illegal drugs or weapons may be used to patrol the parking lot from time to time.
- ⇒ The district may inspect the interiors of student automobiles whenever A school authority has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside the automobiles.
- ⇒ The patrols and inspection referred to above may be conducted without student consent, and without a search warrant.
- ⇒ A student who fails to provide access to the interior of the car upon requests by a school official will be subject to school disciplinary action.

With knowledge and understanding that the District's right to patrol the parking lot, inspect the exterior of vehicles and search the interior of vehicles of illegal for unauthorized items if reasonable suspicion exists.
