### DIPLOMAS

Diplomas are optional because in homeschooling you are not required to receive a diploma. Grace Lutheran offers two types of diplomas. There is a fee for diploma printing. We will have a graduation ceremony at the end of the school year to award diplomas to Senior's graduating. There will be a fee for the graduation ceremony, but the ceremony is optional.

**Grace Diploma:** In order to receive this diploma a student must show and complete the above credit requirements through the homeschooling curriculum you as a parent have designed and setup. Parents who may wish to enroll in select classes offered at Grace Lutheran School may do so as an ala cart selection. Please refer to the ala cart tuition costs for further details. Parents who choose this option may only enroll into a max of 3 courses per semester.

Dual Diploma (online): Alpha Omega Academy/Grace Lutheran: Requires 24 credits

**Dual Diploma:** In order to receive this diploma a student must complete the above credits through Grace Lutheran's online only curriculum with Alpha Omega Academy. Parent's who choose this option for their home school curriculum choice must enroll a minimum of 5 courses per semester.

**College Bound Students:**

ACT testing can be arranged at [www.ACT.org](http://www.ACT.org) Follow the directions to register a date, time and location to be tested. Check with your college choices to find out what their score requirements are. We have a listing of some colleges and universities to help give you an idea.

It is required that all high school subjects are to be listed as such: Algebra I, II, Geometry, American Literature Comp I, American History, Biology, etc.... Never just Math, History, or English.

Only 1 credit per subject title is allowed. Absolutely NO exceptions.

1 credit=135 hours per subject title. Only one grade level per physical school year (August 1-June 1) will be accepted.
