***Jr./Sr. High School
Special Education Teacher (7-12)***

Permanent position beginning with the 2021-22 school year. All applicants are required to possess a valid PA teaching certificate in the area of Special Education. Additional PA teaching certifications, as well as experience with Autism, Emotional Support and Life Skills student learning preferred.

Itinerant Speech and Language Teacher (K-12)

Permanent position beginning with the 2021-22 school year. Master's degree in speech and language pathology and a certificate in School Speech and Language Pathologist (PK-12) or equivalent is required. A qualified Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) must meet at least one of the following: Has a Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC) from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA); or has completed the equivalent educational requirements and work experience necessary for the CCC; or has completed the academic program and is acquiring supervised work experience to qualify for the CCC (See "Supervision of Clinical Fellows"); or is licensed as an SLP.

Secondary Math Teacher

Permanent position beginning with the 2021-22 school year. Minimum Mathematics 7-12 certification required.
