

Report: Pa. school leaders still concerned for operations, finances in '21

Three statewide professional associations have released a report that says Pennsylvania education leaders remain concerned about the continued economic and operational challenges caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The report highlighted anxieties over a number of key issues, including uncertain federal funding, increasing charter school costs and teacher shortages.
