Teacher of Visually Impaired:

The Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit (CSIU) has a full time opening for a Teacher of Visually Impaired. This position provides educational support to students with a documented visual impairment and also may provide instruction in the use of adaptive techniques and/or equipment to overcome problems encountered by students due to their visual impairments. The teacher will exercise initiative and judgment in providing an individualized educational program to each student. The teacher will be an integral member of the multidisciplinary team in the overall development of educational programs for students.

Salary Range: \$48,087 to \$64,121 dependent on education and applicable public school experience. This is an exempt position following a 188 days per year over a 12-month work schedule. This opportunity includes excellent benefits including medical, dental, vision insurance; retirement options including Pennsylvania Public School Employees Retirement System (PSERS) and life insurance options.

Education and knowledge requirements include:

- A Bachelor's degree in the area of visual impairment or education of the visually impaired;
- A valid Pennsylvania teacher certification in the area of Visual Impaired PK-12. Additional certification in Elementary K-6 or Grades PK-4 is preferred.

- Knowledge and the use of Braille.
- Ability to operate instructional devices such as but not limited to: Perkins Braille, CCTV, computers, computer programs, and other technology specific to the visually impaired.
