Trojans Care Fund Receives \$10,000 Donation



Proceeds from the sale of merchandise in the Chambersburg Area Senior High School's student store resulted in a \$10,000 contribution recently to the Trojans Care Fund, a fund established four years ago to help any student in the district who experiences a life-changing event, such as a house fire or a severe car accident.

"The Trojan Care Fund is an Enterprise Fund, a type of fund that exists to support business activities within the high school," explained Dave Livengood, manager of the school store and a CASHS business teacher.

“Last year we gave out 13 gifts to students in the district. These students are identified through a special process. First they are nominated by a teacher, counselor, or even principal. Next, the principal of the school building has to approve the nominee. Once approved, the nomination is sent to the student government advisor. Finally, if approved, the student government president signs off on the student donation which does not exceed \$500,” described Livengood.

“Any profits raised and contributed to this special fund must be used to help students. The store sells primarily spirit wear, and food and snacks. Students who work in the store are a part of our Service Learning program and they are not paid. Instead they receive one quarter credit for every nine weeks worked. In the course of a school year, they earn one credit for their work,” Livengood said.
