
Dear Parents/Guardians:

As we approach the final marking period of the school year, the majority of our Live Stream and Cyber students have returned to traditional face to face instruction. If you still have your student(s) at home in the Live Stream or Cyber Platform, we ask that you consider sending them back to the traditional setting for the last marking period, which begins on April 14. It will be a great way to reintroduce your student(s) to the traditional face to face school environment. If you would like your student(s) to return to the traditional setting for Marking Period 4, please contact your student's school counselor so the necessary arrangements can be made. However, if you prefer to keep your student(s) in the Live Stream or Cyber Platform until the conclusion of the 2020-21 school year, we will honor that choice.

Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, our current plan is to operate in only two platforms: the traditional face to face model and Lake-Lehman Cyber. The Lake-Lehman School District has and will continue to follow all CDC and PA DOH guidelines. As guidance continues to change, we will adjust our protocols and be sure to continue maintaining the safest environment possible for all students.
