TRANSPORTATION

ROUTE BUS RE ENTRY PLAN

11 JULY 2020

We will start by encouraging alternative modes of transportation for students who have other options. This will be the safest option and limit the chance for students to symptom spread while on the bus. Bus riding will be the closest quarters students will be exposed to during a standard Covid-19 school day. All bus riders will be required to abide by the following guidelines.

- Symptom screening will be performed by the bus drivers or by a bus aide.
- A hand sanitizer dispenser will be located in the step well of each bus and students will clean their hands prior to finding their seat.
- Parents will be instructed to stay at the bus stop until their children have been screened and are safely seated on the bus.
- Assigned seating will be required on all buses, if possible we will keep family groups together. Tape or magnets will be used to show students where to sit.
- Since a 6-foot distance cannot be maintained between students sitting two to a seat, face coverings will be worn at all times.

- Drivers should be a minimum of 6 feet from students; drivers and aides must wear face covering.
- Food delivery for distance learning families will be delivered to the
 door by a bus aide or if no aide is available a parent wearing a mask
 will be allowed to enter the bus after all students at that stop have
 been screened and are seated in their assigned seat.
- Adults who do not need to be on the bus will not be permitted on the bus.
- Windows will be open if weather allows.
- Upon arrival at the school, students will exit the bus and head directly to their building. (walking to Allsups will not be allowed)
- Students will then follow the entry plans set in place by their principals.
- Once students are released at the final bell they will head to the bus loop where each bus will have an assigned parking spot with its own color code and marking on the sidewalk 6 ft apart. Students will enter the bus 1 at a time to eliminate them being in close proximity in the isles.

Buses will be disinfected by the driver once they arrive at school and all students are in the building. They will then again be disinfected by the driver after the evening route. Mondays all buses will get a deep cleaning performed by the transportation department. All cleaning chemicals and MSDSs will be stored on the bus in a secure container. The food delivery coolers will be stored on the bus and

will fill the seat directly behind the Driver to help ensure students keep a safe 6ft distance.

All route buses have video cameras with audio features. Drivers will be instructed to follow a 3 strikes policy for removal of face coverings.

The only persons allowed to ride a Cloudcroft bus without a face covering are those who can provide a Doctor's note excusing them from wearing one.
