



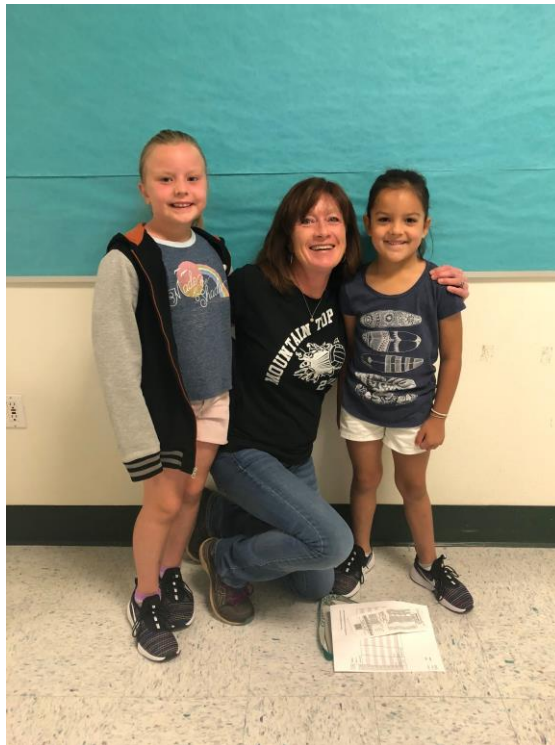

SB-9 Vote - School Capital Improvement Funding!

(Also known as the two-mill levy)

This Act provides funding for routine school maintenance, improving school grounds, buildings, remodeling, furnishings, computers, software and technology infrastructure.

These projects protect the taxpayers' investment in our buildings and assures they are safe, functional places for teaching and learning!

Districts must ask the voters to reauthorize the tax - and...No, this election is for the "*continuance*" of the existing two mill levy. Taxes will NOT INCREASE upon passage of the SB-9!
