Mission Statement

Christian Burial is a Corporal Work of Mercy.

The Church's whole Rite of Christian Burial for the faithful departed and providing for their temporal resting places gives honor to them and witness to our faith in the Resurrection.

This cemetery is intended for the interment of Catholics who are entitled to the Rite of Christian Burial according to the rules and the discipline of the Roman Catholic Church and directives for Christian Burial as set forth by the Diocese of Raleigh.

Questions regarding the burial of non-Catholic members of a lot holder's family, or of any other person not entitled to Christian Burial according to the rules and the discipline of the Roman Catholic Church and abiding with regulations of the Diocese of Raleigh, shall be the decision of the Pastor of the St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church, whose decision is final.

Burial Options

St. Anthony's Catholic Cemetery currently provides for ground burial or inurnment in our Columbarium and is located on Camp Easter Road in Southern Pines, North Carolina.

The cemetery plots are fifty-one inches by one hundred eleven inches. A vault is required at our cemetery to enclose the casket, however, a vault for inurnment is optional. One casket **or** two urns may be buried within one plot.

One niche in the Columbarium will provide for the inurnment of two urns. It is not possible for a casket and an urn to be in one cemetery plot.

An eight-foot granite statuary, depicted on the cover of this pamphlet, is centered in this beautifully landscaped two-acre cemetery. The serenity of this setting is complimented by our impressive Columbarium, which is located at the entrance to the Cemetery.

Fee Schedule

St. Anthony's Catholic Cemetery is competitively priced with the existing cemeteries in the area.

The fee for a ground plot is \$1,100.00 while the fee for a niche in the Columbarium is \$2,400.00. These prices will be re-evaluated yearly and are based on the local market.

When purchasing a niche, urns are not necessary, containers are included with the niche.

There will be a fee for opening and closing the gravesites. The fee for the ground plot is \$500.00 and the fee for the Columbarium is \$200.00. This fee applies to each burial or each inurnment.

There is a one-time fee of \$110.00, for the perpetual care of a gravesite and niche.

This schedule attempts to reflect the teachings of the Church by treating each burial similarly and not prompting the faithful to choose cremation primarily for financial reasons.
