A Message From the Superior Unified School District

1. SUSD will be extending remote-learning until at least Monday, February 1st. Remote-learning is recommended by both ADHS and Pinal County Health Department when all three benchmarks are red. This is also due to the increase in COVID cases in Superior.
2. SUSD will re-evaluate returning to hybrid the week of January 25th. (Students will need to continue to login to their classes during remote-learning). The on-site option will be available during that time for students with special needs and those whose parents are essential workers.
3. Lunches will continue to be delivered during remote-learning. Please notify each school site if you DON'T want a lunch delivered for you child(ren).
4. Students are responsible for taking care of their assigned devices at all times.
5. Please don't send your child(ren) to school if they are ill. We will send them home.
6. Do not send your child(ren) to school if there is a positive contact in their home. We will send them home.
