



### Back to School Options

Families can choose an option that best serves their circumstances to safely return to school. SMUSD is offering three pathways for learning dependent on interest and available staffing. In-person learning will be delayed until at least August 17<sup>th</sup>; In-Person students will utilize Remote Learning until they are allowed to physically return to campuses.

In-Person	Remote Learning	Online
<p>Students are welcomed back, in-person, at all SMUSD schools. Every campus will be following preventative protocols and making modifications to the learning environment, to prioritize student and staff safety, as outlined in the Back to School Plan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preschool – high school (P/K-12)</li> <li>• 4 days per week, Tuesday – Friday, per calendar</li> <li>• Preventive safety measures</li> <li>• Staff and students wear masks when required</li> <li>• Limited student movement (maintain cohorts)</li> <li>• SMUSD teachers and curriculum</li> <li>• Instruction in core content</li> <li>• Social-emotional support</li> <li>• Specials and electives</li> <li>• Accommodations and support services provided</li> <li>• Recess breaks</li> <li>• Virtual extra-curricular activities</li> <li>• Clubs/activities as allowed</li> <li>• Athletics as allowed</li> <li>• In-Person students will use Remote Learning until allowed to return to campuses</li> </ul>	<p>Students with the need for flexibility can start the year learning at home and then transitions back to In-Person learning at scheduled intervals throughout the year. Families may choose to enter Remote Learning during the year as needed (e.g. for quarantine). Teachers will deliver instruction at scheduled times daily, for students to interact with the teacher and other students. Teachers will maintain office hours for additional support. Students will complete assignments in Google Classroom.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preschool – high school (P/K-12)</li> <li>• 4 days per week, Tuesday – Friday, per calendar</li> <li>• Live, real-time, teacher-led instruction at designated times during the day with flexible learning activities through Google Classroom</li> <li>• Flexibility in transitioning to and from In-Person learning each quarter or as needed due to quarantines</li> <li>• SMUSD teachers and curriculum</li> <li>• Accommodations and support services provided</li> <li>• Limited specials provided (PE, art music, technology)</li> <li>• Participate in activities and events with current school</li> <li>• District devices available; reliable internet connection required (10 Mbps download)</li> </ul>	<p>Students will be able to access their learning at any time or day, at their own pace by actively listening to video-recorded lessons that they can stop and start to complete interactive lessons. The learning platform, SchoolsPLP, provides a curriculum and digital instructional resources designed specifically for online learning. A SMUSD teacher will monitor and support each child’s progress. The SMUSDOnline school is designed for full-year enrollment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kindergarten – high school (K-12)</li> <li>• 7 days per week, 24/7</li> <li>• Younger students will need adult support at home</li> <li>• Enrollment on Online School is for the entire year, without flexibility to transition back and forth</li> <li>• High school online enrollment is by course, such that mid-year transitions are an option</li> <li>• Self-paced, personalized learning through SchoolPLP</li> <li>• Teacher support</li> <li>• Core subject areas</li> <li>• District devices available; reliable internet connection required (10 Mbps download)</li> </ul>
