Below you will find all the information you need to get this year started.

<b>Before the First Day of School</b>	Make sure you submit your signed Information Update Form and the Application for Free and Reduced Lunch. <u>Both of these documents are required to complete the registration process.</u> You can scan and e-mail documents to <a href="mailto:enrollment@muhs.com">enrollment@muhs.com</a> , mail the documents to MUHS Attn: Registrar 1801 East Fir St. Cottonwood, AZ 86326 or drop them in our drop box located in the horseshoe parking lot off of Fir Street.
<b>First Day of School</b>	Thursday, August 6 <sup>th</sup> is the first day of school. Please mark your calendars.
<b>Remote Learning Details</b>	<p><b>Edgenuity</b> – This is the on-line platform that we are using for student learning. Here is a link to the student log-in page: <a href="https://auth.edgenuity.com/Login/Login/Student">https://auth.edgenuity.com/Login/Login/Student</a></p> <p><b>Log-In Information</b> – included in this mailer is a document with your student's user name and password for Edgenuity. Students will need to update their password the first time they use the system. Make sure to keep the user name and password in a safe place. We suggest taking a picture of it with a phone so that it is easily accessible!</p> <p><b>Course Information</b> – Students will be assigned modules for the first seven days to help boost some of the learning from the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of last year. Beginning August 17<sup>th</sup>, students will begin coursework for the classes they will remain in for the academic year (whether online or in person – more information will be provided). . **Advisory Teacher** – Your student’s Advisory Teacher is your “go to” person for their remote learning. The Advisory teacher will be communicating with you and your student regularly to make sure that your student has what they need to be successful. Your Advisory teacher’s name and contact information are enclosed in this mailer. Make sure to look at that information as some adjustments to Advisory teachers has been made for this year.

**Attendance** – Daily attendance is required for remote learning. Attendance is a two-step process. First, students will log-in to their Advisory teacher’s Google Classroom and complete the Daily Attendance Form. Your Advisory Teacher will provide instructions on how to do this prior to the first day of school. Second, students will log-in to Edgenuity to complete their course work.

**Daily Progress** – Students will need to work on coursework at least 4 hours daily (Monday – Friday). Students can choose to work when they want to but we encourage families to set up a schedule so that students can get into a routine. Students can choose to work on their coursework on the weekends but it is not required.

**Devices and Wi-Fi** – Devices will be available (1 per family) while supplies last (we have more devices on the way); we will deploy additional computers as needed. If your student needs a device or assistance with Wi-Fi, please visit our website at [www.mingusunion.com](http://www.mingusunion.com), submit a request for a laptop and/or hotspot, and our Bookstore Manager will schedule an appointment for pick-up. Your \$40 book deposit covers a school computer and hot spot (if needed). Please be prepared to pay the book deposit at the time of pick-up if you haven’t already done so. Parent and student will both need to sign the technology agreement, so please be sure to come to the pick-up appointment together.
