

MUHS Remote Learning Plan - August 17th, 2020

Great job, Marauders! Now that you've had the opportunity to learn how to use Edgenuity and have become acquainted with our communication systems, it's time to move into our next phase of learning. Beginning August 17th, Learning Loss modules will be replaced with your six high school classes. Please do not worry if you did not fully complete the Learning Loss modules. As long as you were working consistently in the Learning Loss modules, you will receive a "P" grade (pass). This grade will transfer into your Advisory class once we return to in-person learning. You will be able to track your progress through Edgenuity. Completion of your courses is very important because this work counts toward your high school credits.

Remote Learning Details	<p>Edgenuity – This is the on-line platform that we will continue to use for student learning.</p> <p>Course Information- The six courses on each student's schedule will be uploaded into Edgenuity. The current three "learning loss" modules will be archived. Beginning Monday, students will be responsible for logging into Edgenuity and working on each of the six courses on their regular Mingus schedule. The work on Edgenuity is mandatory and does count towards your attendance and grade in each class.</p> <p>Advisory Teacher – Your student's Advisory Teacher is your "go to" person for their remote learning. The Advisory teacher will be communicating with you and your student regularly to make sure that your student has what they need to be successful. Advisory teachers will host weekly Zoom/Google Meets meetings with their students to check-in, provide support, and answer any questions.</p> <p>Academic Support and Supplemental Instruction (beginning the week of August 24th)- Teachers are developing web links and sites to offer assistance for struggling students. Information about Google Meets and support links will be provided by Advisory teachers next week. If students are experiencing difficulty with their subjects, please reach out to your Advisory teacher so they can connect you with a content teacher.</p> <p>Attendance – Daily attendance is required for remote learning. Attendance is a two-step process. First, students will log-in to their Advisory teacher's Google Classroom and complete the Daily Attendance Form. Second, students will log-in to Edgenuity to complete their course work. <u>Students must log-in to Google Classroom and Edgenuity to be marked as "present".</u></p> <p>Daily Progress – Students will need to work on coursework at least 4 hours per class every week. This can vary based on pace, but students need to maintain adequate progress in Edgenuity. Students can choose to work when they want to but we encourage families to set up a schedule so that students can get into a routine. Your Advisory teacher will provide you with a sample schedule to assist your planning.</p> <p>Encourage your student to actively use the Assignment Calendar in Edgenuity to track what course work he or she should be completing each day.</p>
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Here are some important steps that will support success as an online student:

- **Establish routines and expectations.** Create a flexible routine and talk about how it's working. Chunk your days into predictable segments and encourage your student to get up, get dressed, and get ready to learn.
- **Choose a good place to learn.** Set up a physical location that's dedicated to school-focused activities. Minimize distractions and practice good digital safety.
- **Stay in touch.** Teachers will be communicating regularly. Make sure everyone knows how to find the help they need to be successful.
- **Help student's "own" their learning.** No one expects parents to be full-time teachers or to be educational content matter experts. Provide support and encouragement, and expect your student to do their part. Struggling is allowed and is a pathway to learning!
- **Encourage physical activity and exercise.** Moving is vital to health, well-being, and readiness for learning.

Devices and Wi-Fi – Students and families that need devices should contact the Bookstore. Students and families that need tech support with devices/hot spots will contact their Advisory teacher who will problem solve with the IT Department.

Special Education-Students will have the opportunity to come to the school on scheduled days and times to receive support services in person. The special education team will provide services and adapt Edgenuity to the needs of individual students and supplement with any additional services needed.

English Language Learners- Students will have the opportunity to come to the school on scheduled days and times to receive support services in person. The EL team will provide services and adapt Edgenuity to the needs of individual students and supplement with any additional services needed.

Dual Enrollment-

Students will access their Dual Enrollment courses through Google Classroom located on their teacher's website. Specific details for each class will be communicated by the DE teacher.

Advanced Placement-

AP Studio Art and AP Chemistry students will access their AP class through Google Classroom located on their teacher's website.

AP Biology, AP World History, AP US History, AP Psychology, and AP Language students will access their courses through Edgenuity. Supplemental materials will be posted in Google Classroom located on teacher websites.

Specific details for each class will be communicated by the AP teacher.
