Dear TUSD Parents/Guardians,

TUSD will be changing its curbside pick-up days and times. Friday, August 28, 2020 will be the last day for our normal 5-day a week curbside pick-up. As a continued commitment to providing nutritious meals to our students, we will be transitioning to a once a week pick-up that will begin on Monday, August 31, 2020. The once a week pick-up will have a 5-day meal kit that will include your child's breakfast and lunch meals for the 5-day school week. We are encouraging those that are remotely learning to participate in this pick-up service. The pick-up hours for Huachuca City School will be from 7:30-8:00 A.M. The pick-up hours for Tombstone will be at Walter J. Meyer from 8:15-8:45 A.M. This pick-up service will be every Monday until further notice. Please keep in mind that cafeteria staff will have to verify student enrollment in our district as well as eligibility before releasing any food items. As always, if you have any questions regarding foodservice, don't hesitate to reach out to myself, one of the cafeteria staff or the administrators at your perspective schools.
