Dear TUSD parents,

With the new year approaching quickly I wanted to take a few minutes to let you know what is happening in the foodservice world of TUSD. USDA has extended all of the currently installed waivers for the 2021-2022 school year, this means that all students will eat FREE of charge at all of our school sites. **There will be no need to fill out free and reduced lunch applications for the current school year.** If you require income verification for anything outside of lunches please let your school site know, they will have income verification forms that can be used to verify income. Students that attend Tombstone High School will need money if they intend on purchasing Ala Carte items that will be available through the cafeteria. I will be releasing those items and prices sometime this week.

At the high school we will be implementing some new things that will help with the student's ability to access meals without going into the cafeteria to get them. We will have a breakfast by the bus that will start on day one of school. This will be a cart that will have breakfast available to the students as they enter campus. Our ala carte items will be available in the main courtyard of the high school during lunch as well as tables that will have a full lunch meal available to grab and go. This will help alleviate the traffic that we are expecting with the increased student count at the high school.

Our adult meals prices will not change this coming school year, they will be \$2.30 for breakfast and \$3.95 for lunch. Please feel free to join your students for breakfast or lunch anytime you would like.

We will not be offering any curbside meals at this time, if the need arises, we will be ready to serve those needs. If the need is a current one please let us know and we can accommodate on a case by case basis.

We want to thank you for allowing us to serve healthy and nutritious meals to your children. If you have any questions at all, please don't hesitate to let myself or Tammi Brice know and we will do our best to assist.
