Dear Tombstone and Surrounding areas,

Tombstone Unified School District has some great news for the communities that we serve. The USDA has just released a waiver that is going to allow us to operate under special guidelines until December 31, 2020. These guidelines will allow us to feed ANY child from the ages of 0-18 regardless if they are enrolled/residing in our district/community, students or their parents will be able to pick-up meals at our schools. These guidelines will also allow ALL of our currently enrolled students, regardless of eligibility to eat free as well. To accommodate these rules we will begin immediately offering meals to our communities. If students are not attending in person at any school site, these meals will be on a curbside pick-up ONLY basis.

We will have one pick-up site in Tombstone and one pick-up site in Huachuca City. We will be offering a five-day meal time kit that will provide nutritious meals for the 5-day week.

Sites and Times are:

Beginning Tuesday, September 8, 2020:

In Tombstone: Walter J. Meyer Elementary school will be from 8:15-8:45 AM on Mondays.

In Huachuca City: Huachuca City School will be from 7:15-8:00 A.M. on Mondays.

(Kits will be available on Tuesday, September 8, due to the holiday on Monday 9/7. Our normal kit pick-up day will be on Monday's)
